

School response if a child displays symptoms during school time.

Concern raised by the child themselves or by an adult supervising.

Person is isolated immediately. Child's parents will be contacted.

Child **must** be collected **immediately** from school.

Mandatory 10 days of self-isolation for the child and 14 for the household.

Negative Test Result:

If the child is fit and well, they can now return to school. Household stops isolating as well.

Negative test

Parents **MUST** inform school of test outcome **immediately**.

Test **MUST** be arranged and **must** take place.

All families must engage with the Test and Trace process.

Positive test

Positive Test Result: The child must complete the compulsory 10 days self-isolation from the date of the test.

School will contact the Local Authority Covid Team. Based upon their advice, the rest of the bubble may close and all pupils in this bubble will need to undertake 14 days of compulsory self-isolation. If children develop symptoms in this time, they must be tested. School must be informed of the test outcome.

What if my child displays symptoms at home?

Isolate your child where possible.

Do not allow your child to attend school or other public places.

Mandatory 10 days of self-isolation for the child and 14 for the household.

Inform school if your child is displaying symptoms.

Parents **MUST** inform school of test outcome **immediately.**

Test **MUST** be arranged and **must** take place.

All families must engage with the Test and Trace process.

If a result is received on a weekend, please email admin@thelinksprimary.org.uk

As soon as any member of your household tests positive for COVID-19, or displays symptoms, you MUST keep your child off school for 14 days regardless if they are showing symptoms or not (you must engage with the NHS Test and Trace process).

If any other member of the household starts to display symptoms, you must self isolate for a further 10 days and seek medical advice.
