Seesaw

Seesaw can be accessed online or through the app.



Search and download Seesaw app from any app store (it is free).

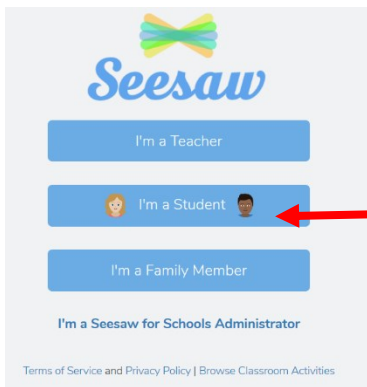

Children have all been given a new unique personal sign in code (last year's codes have expired and can no longer be used).

If using a laptop or computer children will need to click 'log in'.

They will then need to use their home sign in code to sign in. Children do not need to use an email address or password. Type their code here and click 'Go'.

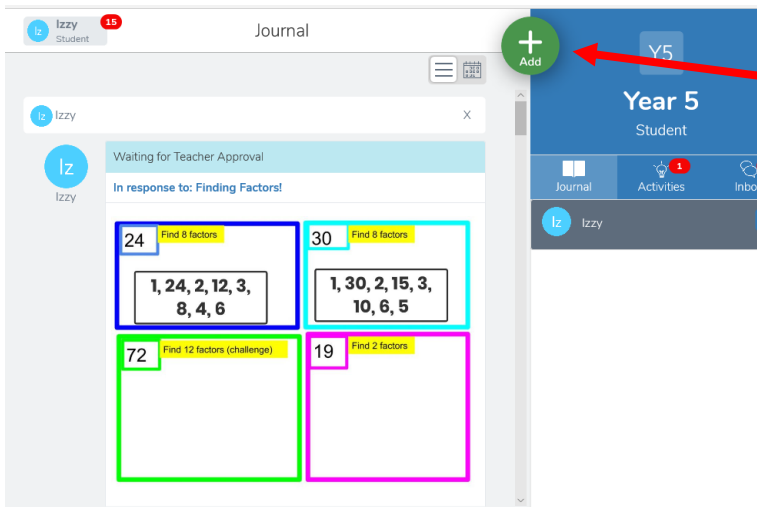
Or scan the QR code from your child's individual letter.

Recording home Reading

There are a number of ways children can record their home reading through Seesaw. They can:

- Send a photo
- Send a video
- Send a note

How to send a photo/video/upload



1. Once logged in click on the green 'Add button'.

2. Select what you want to upload.

Allows you to take a photo. You can use this to take photos your work.

Allows you to draw a picture or paste a copied image.

Allows you to record a video.

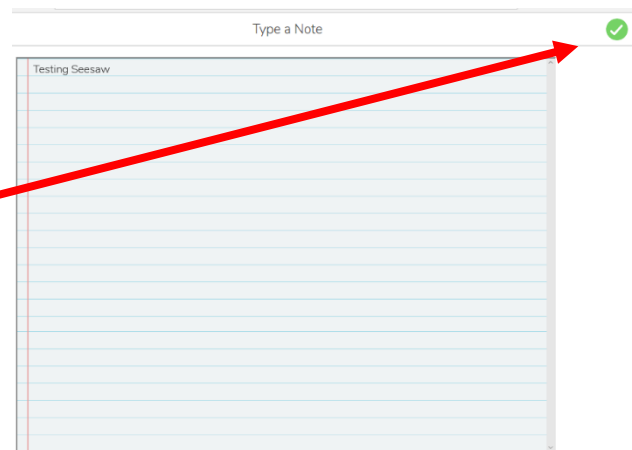
