Welcome to Year 3

PΕ

PE is every Monday and Tuesday afternoon. Children need to come into school dressed in appropriate sportswear for outdoor PE lessons on these days.

Reading

Reading is a vital skill and we would encourage children to read as much as possible at home. We are continuing to use Seesaw to record home reading. This can be done through videoing a child read, sending a picture of the book or page number, writing a note to say reading has taken place; no comments are needed.



It is important children have a good understanding of what they are reading, so please question your child using the prompts I have given you. Reading books can be changed immediately on the day the child brings it back to school.

Spellings

A spelling rule is taught every Monday and the children are given 10 words to learn throughout the week. Spellings will be sent home via Seesaw and Edshed. Spelling lessons will take place three times a week with the final lesson including a spelling test on a Friday.

Timetables

Year 3 is a crucial year for times tables learning. Children are expected to learn multiplication facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables (in addition to the 0, 2, 5 and 10 tables), and to use practical and written methods to multiply and divide two-digit numbers (for example, 15 x 4). We encourage the use of Times Tables Rock Stars and have included your child's log in details in this pack.

Marvellous Me

We use Marvellous Me to send messages and reminders as well as to let you know when your child/children are doing particularly well with a project or activity in school, including Star of the Week, Writer of the Week and Mathematician of the Week.

Home Arrangements

In Year 3, your child still needs to be collected by an adult.

We have your home arrangements for adults collecting. If these details change (even just as a one off), please let us know the new information as soon as possible. We cannot let a child leave school unless it is with an adult identified on the home arrangement you completed at the start of the year.
